

Tool Required	Parts List

1. Referring to your owner's manual if needed, start by removing the stock seat from your motorcycle.
2. The Corbin saddle installs like stock with brackets premounted on the saddle.
3. Slip the adjustable mounting front tongue into the slot by the gas tank. Center the rear of the saddle over the pin then press firmly down, right over the pin position as it "clicks" into place (*Figure 1*). Double check the installation by pulling up on the rear of the seat, making sure it's secure.




4. To remove the saddle, insert the stock key into the lock system, turn the key clockwise and pull it up from the rear. If the key seems a bit stiff to turn, push down on the seat over the locking system, to assist the seat as the rubber grommets are new and need time to break in.

NOTE: Though we strive for a perfect fit, the bikes mounting points and hardware can slightly vary on tolerance and fit.



NOTE: If the front of the seat is a little loose and has some play, or is a bit too snug, the front tongue can be adjusted as needed by loosening the bolts and moving the bracket up or down (*Figure 2*). The rear bracket is adjustable too and you can add washers under the rear bracket if necessary (*Figure 3*).
